License Agreement for Emergency Providers

This template agreement (the “Template Agreement”) is intended to serve as a starting point for Head Start grantees (each, a “Grantee”) in their negotiations with emergency childcare providers for the temporary use of the Grantees’ facilities, and should be tailored to meet a Grantee’s specific requirements. The Template Agreement should not be construed as legal advice for any particular facts or circumstances.

By making the Template Agreement available to Grantees, the National Head Start Association (“NHSA”) is not acting as counsel to or advising any Grantee on any matter, including in terms of applicable local, state or federal laws or any Grantee’s other unique circumstances. NHSA will in no way be liable for any damages resulting from use of the Template Agreement.
